Vaka Motu 'Mariana Islands' – LSB 58



Lloyd Stevenson Boatbuilders is proud to continue working with the 'Okeanos Foundation' in the exciting production of ocean voyaging Vaka. We recently launched Vaka Motu – Mariana Islands, our second Vaka. It continues to be a rewarding process combining today's modern boatbuilding technologies with traditional methods of Polynesian construction and culture.

Vaka Motu 'Okeanos' LSB 59, 60 and 61

After the successful launch of LSB 57 and 58 work immediately began on three more Vaka. Marty and his team are now managing the three builds at once. <http://okeanos-foundation.org/>



Each hull is constructed of e-glass and foam core using advanced epoxy resin infusion processes. In contrast to these modern methods, traditional aspects will remain clearly visible with each hull lashed together using wooden beams and ropes.

Refit & Repair



Our refit department continues to be busy with the recent refit of Lady Alison, a 65' Elite sport fisher built by LSB in 2006. Royce and his team gave Lady Alison a full repaint, new teak decks, new upholstery, new engines and electronics.

The 14 m Elite mid-pilothouse Kaihanu is also in for some major cockpit changes, including a new teak deck, built in BBQ and new genset.

11.75 Sport Tender



LSB is also proud to announce construction has begun on an 11.75m Sport Tender, due for delivery in Dec 2018. The multipurpose tender is custom designed for fishing and adventure. She will service an 80m superyacht currently under construction at Nobiskrug Superyachts in Germany. Shaun Smith and his team are excited to get stuck into this unique project.
